HOW DOES MAKEY MAKEY WORK?

Makey Makey works through opening and closing circuits, just like any other button. Instead of the circuit being closed underneath your keyboard, the circuit is closed through the conductive objects you connect with alligator clips. When the circuit is closed, the Makey Makey sends a command to your computer, just like a button pressed on a keyboard.

WHAT OPERATING SYSTEMS CAN MAKEY MAKEY WORK ON?

Makey Makey works on Windows, Mac, Chromebook and on many flavors of Linux (Ubuntu, etc.). If the device supports a USB keyboard or mouse, it should work with Makey Makey.
