Named-user licensing

- Licenses for each individual. Rights to install on two computers for work and home use. Bring your own device (BYOD) support available for student-owned computers.
- Choice of All Apps or Single App option.
- · Online services and storage included.

Device licensing

- Licenses for each computer, rather than each user, with rights to install on one computer per license.
 Bring your own device (BYOD) support available.
- Choice of All Apps or Single App option.
- Online services and storage not included.

<u>Tips</u>

Customers may purchase a Single App option to lower costs, but remind them that creative tasks are often interrelated and providing just a single app may stifle creativity. If they need 2-3 apps, the All Apps plan is more cost effective.

K-12 customers may also purchase the K-12 School Site License (100+ seats at a single site) and the District License (500+ seats across a district or legal entity).
